Blend: 100% Grenache Gris

Tasting notes and food pairings: Reminiscent of a great white Rhone style; the wine is very rich and full on the pallet; aromas of fresh white peach; dry and supple. High toned fruit with a rich middle palate. Think “viognier light”. . .
